them i also smooth out the writing and add bits of information i d forgotten during the first brain to fingers dump and that s exactly what i ve done for this revised edition as a result the text is 10 1 percent shorter than the first edition it s more to the point and it s where the manuscript would have ended up under normal conditions publisher s website
